## **Home School Agreement**

**This must be completed and returned to school in order for your child to return to school.**

**September 2021**

### **Pippins Primary school will do its best to:**

- ✓ Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to COVID-19 pandemic.
- ✓ Adhere to the social distancing and mitigation rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;
- ✓ Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs.
- ✓ Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19; this will mean your child will need to be tested asap; if positive, to self-isolate for 10 days (test results must be shared with school).
- ✓ In the unlikely case of a class, group or small number of children needing to self-isolate, or there is a local lockdown, requiring pupils to remain at home, we will offer high quality remote learning.
- ✓ Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well as the expectations outlined in this agreement.
- ✓ Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, email and the school website.

### **Parents - To help my child at school, I know and understand that:**

- ✓ If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school; we will get tested asap and if positive, self-isolate for 10. I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone.
- ✓ On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to at least 1 or more metres social distancing rules.
- ✓ When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child.
- ✓ I will ensure that only one adult drops off and picks up my child. I will ensure this adult is a member of my household.
- ✓ My child must only bring a named water bottle, clear pencil case, with specified items and a small bag.
- ✓ I will ensure my child's water bottle is clearly labelled and disinfected each day before they come to school.
- ✓ My child will need to use good hand, nose and mouth hygiene measures; we will reinforce these at home.
- ✓ I will not be allowed into the school unless I have made an appointment. I will communicate via phone or email.
- ✓ I will arrive at the school gate to drop off my child at the allocated time. I will leave immediately. If I need to speak to a member of staff I will do this via email or phone.
- ✓ I need to support all staff in their efforts to create a 'safe as possible' environment during this crisis.
- ✓ I will contact the school if I am concerned about my child's wellbeing so that staff can take action.
- ✓ Read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home.
- ✓ I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parent/carer and emergency contact details. I will ensure my contact details are up to date on Arbor.
- ✓ If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return until they can be safe.

<b>Child - I will do my best to:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ I will adhere to the social distancing rules in class and on the playground.</li> <li>✓ Tell an adult if I feel unwell.</li> <li>✓ Not bring things into school from home, except my named water bottle, clear pencil case, a small bag and change of clothes for PE if required.</li> <li>✓ Only use the equipment provided to me by school and no other and <b>not to share</b> my equipment.</li> <li>✓ Follow good hand, nose and mouth hygiene: coughing and sneezing into a tissue (catch it-bin-it-kill-it) and to practice this at home.</li> <li>✓ Follow good hand hygiene – use soap/gel and water for 20 seconds/hand sanitiser.</li> <li>✓ Walk to school whenever I can.</li> <li>✓ Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others.</li> <li>✓ Follow these expectations and know that if I don't I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.</li> <li>✓ If I am in Year 6, I can walk to and from home, once I have returned my permission slip in the autumn term.</li> </ul>
